

Incoming Wire Transfer Instructions



To receive a wire transfer to your UFCU account, please share the following instructions with the person or financial institution sending the funds:

1. Fill in your account information below and print this page.
2. Give it to the person who sends you money.
3. That person will take this form to their financial institution (the sending institution).
4. They will use the following information to complete the wire transfer to your account at UFCU (the receiving institution).

Important Notes

- **International Wires** — UFCU does **not** have a direct international correspondent bank. The sending institution must use its own **U.S.-based correspondent bank** to complete the transfer.
- **SWIFT Transfers** — The sending bank must use the **SWIFT code** of its U.S. correspondent bank and include the UFCU wire instructions above.
- **Foreign Currency** — UFCU **cannot receive foreign currency**. Funds sent in foreign currency will be converted to U.S. Dollars by the U.S. correspondent bank before reaching UFCU.
- **Account Posting** — If you do not have a UFCU Checking Account (ending in 0080), or if there is a restriction on your account, funds will be posted to your Savings Account (ending in 0000). Please contact us if you would like to request further distribution.
